



Global Nutrition Report Independent Expert Group

Declaration of Interests

Since its inception in 2014, the Global Nutrition Report has been funded by multiple public and private donor institutions¹; with no single funder having the ability to influence the content and analysis contained in the report. To further protect the independence of this content, all members of the Independent Expert Group (IEG) are required to declare any current financial, professional or other interest that may influence their ability to be impartial when serving on the IEG. This includes any interest that may affect, or may reasonably be perceived to affect, your objectivity and independence. For example, the organisation you work for, or organisations for whom you consult, may be perceived to affect your partiality since you have a financial relationship with them. Being a member of an advisory group or board may have the same affect. Since these interests may, even if unconsciously, influence your perspectives when serving on the IEG, they should be declared. Please be sure to declare all current financial and non-financial relationships with the private sector, even if short term.

Interest
Financial I receive a salary from my position as Programme Adviser of the Strategic Food System Programme of the United Nation Food and Organization (FAO). I do not accept any private or public sector funding for any aspect of my work or any remuneration that is not associated with my current position at FAO. As part of my position I participate in events as speaker but without remuneration. In certain occasions the organizer cover directly the cost (travel and lodging only). During the last year this was the case with the Municipality of Lisbon, Portugal and University of Cardiff, UK, as both institutions paid for travel-associated expenses for me to participate in their events.
Non-financial I have no commitment with any institution other than FAO. In the recent past I was active in professional groups (i.e. International Society of Horticultural Sciences, Institute of Food Technology) and board member of events sponsored by those. With FAO, and before my recent position, I served as focal point for the joint agreement between FAO and the World Union of Wholesale Markets, and the Kuehne Foundation (specialized on Logistics Systems), sitting in several panels to provide support to their activities (e.g. organization of technical events).

We are only requesting declaration of current relationships. If, subsequent to your declaration in this form, new interests that may affect your participation in the IEG arise during your term, it is your duty


to disclose them to the IEG Co-chairs in the first instance in order for them to determine an appropriate process with which to handle them, and for you to update this form as required.
